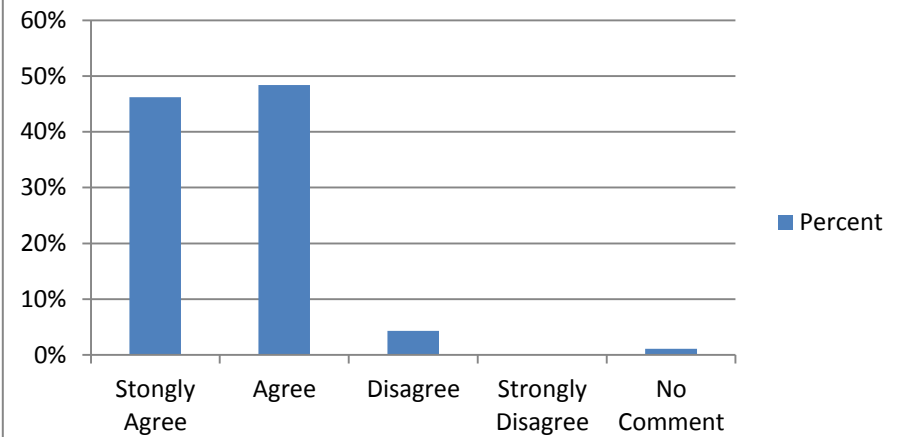

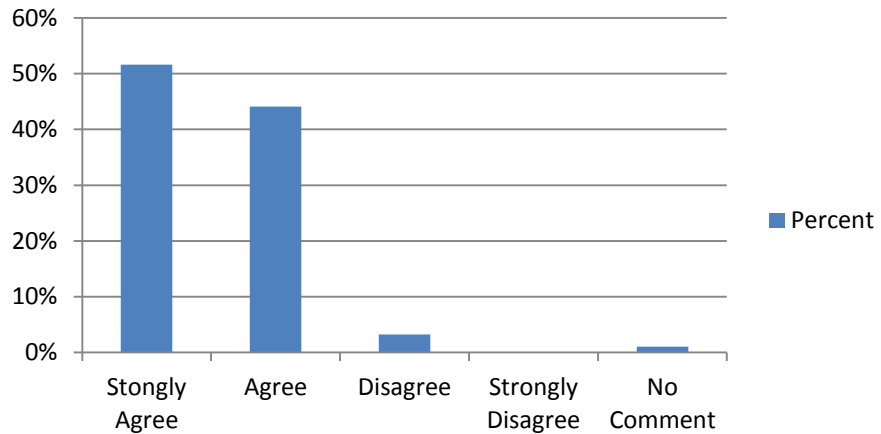

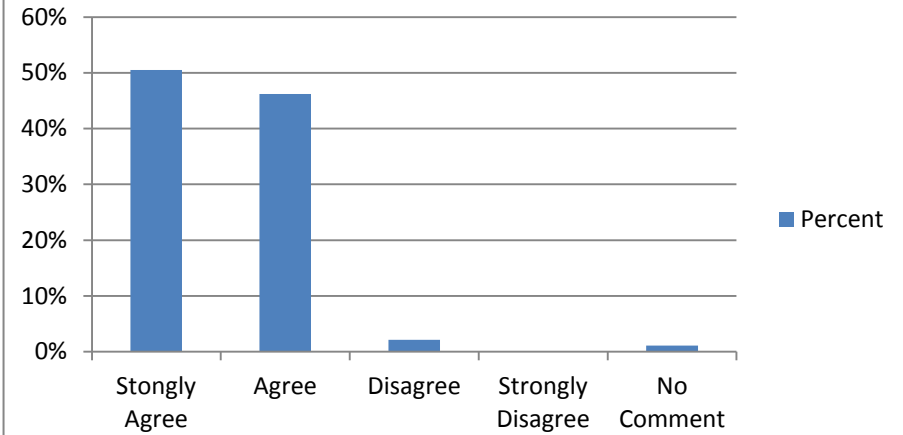

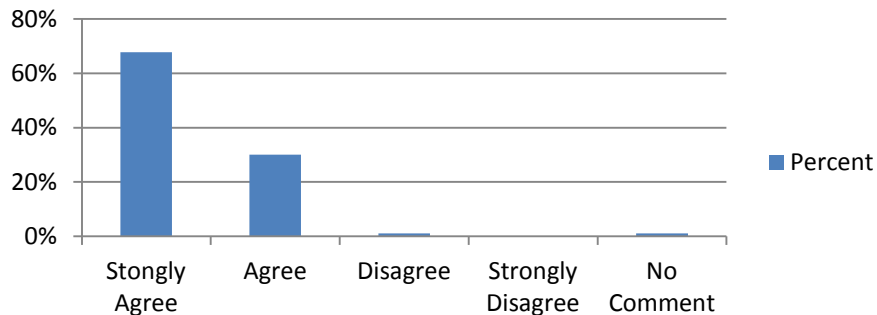

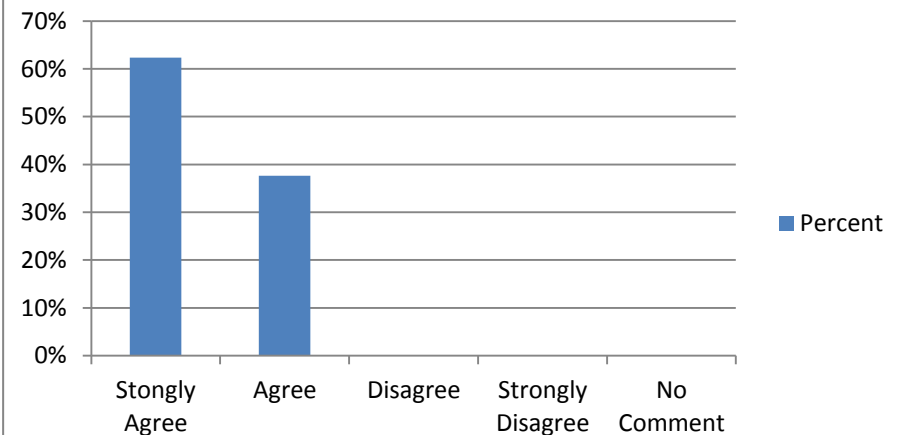

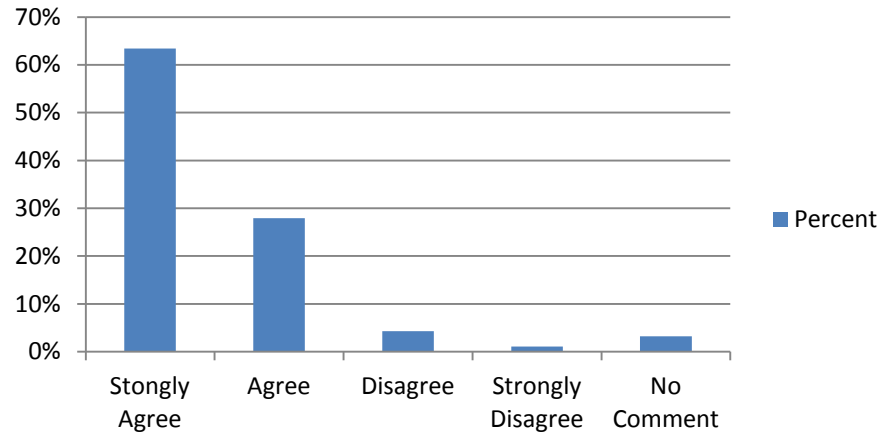

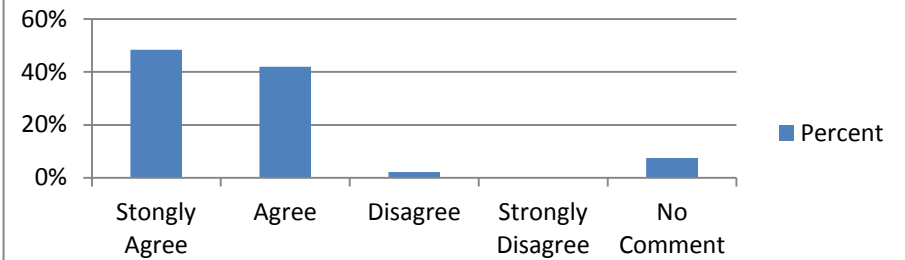

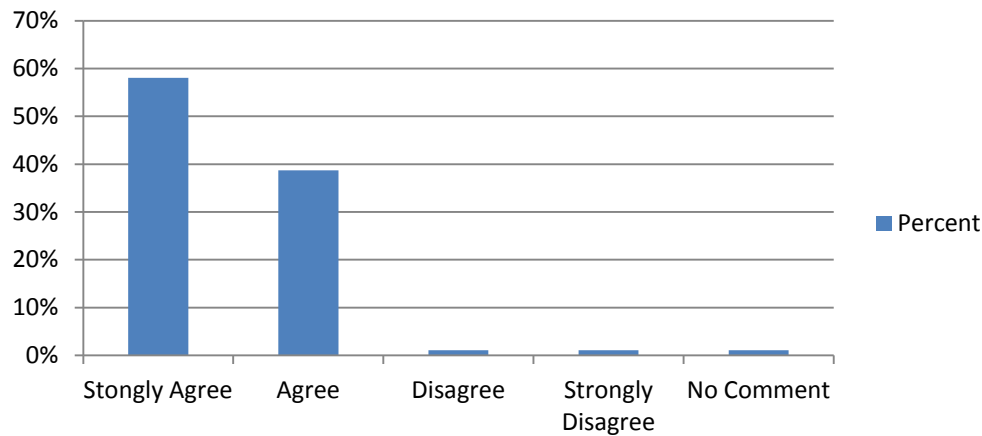

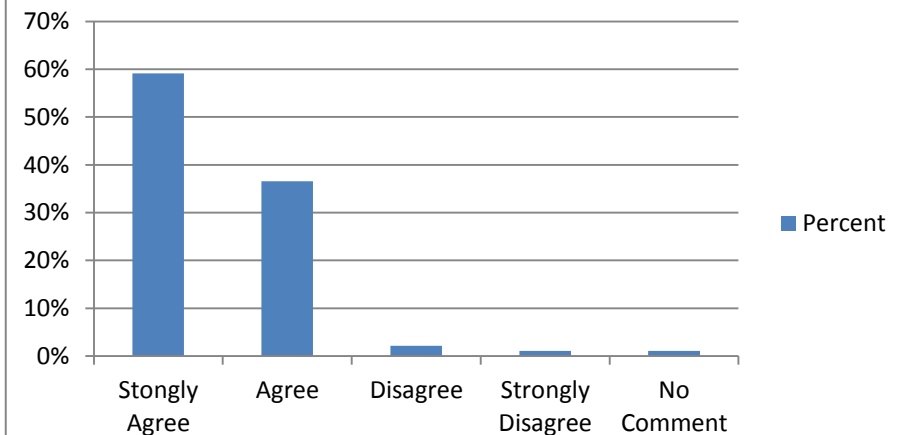

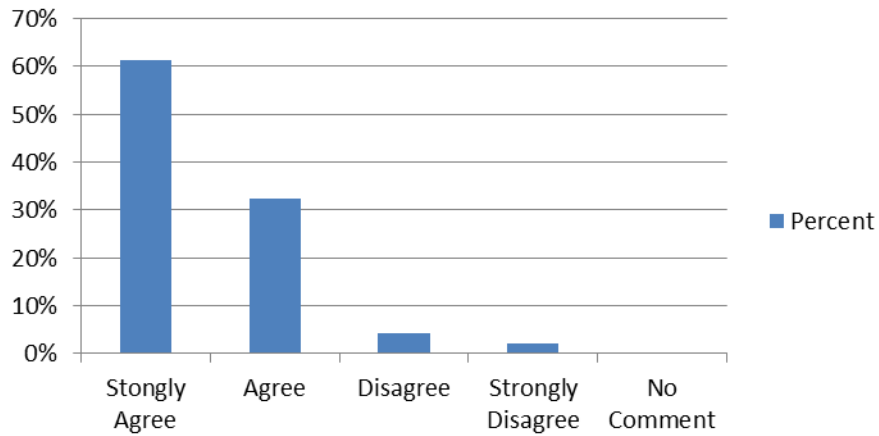

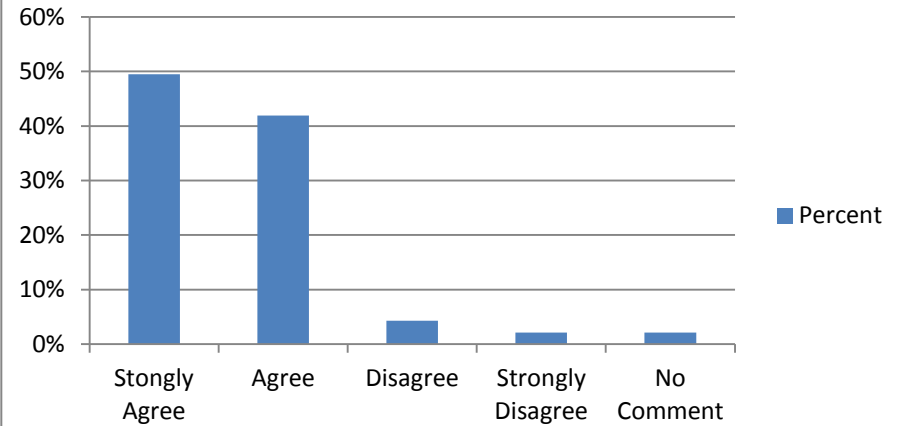

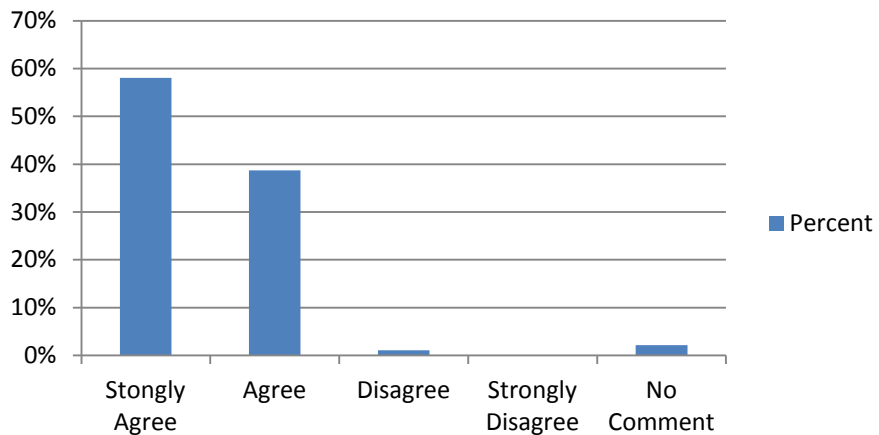

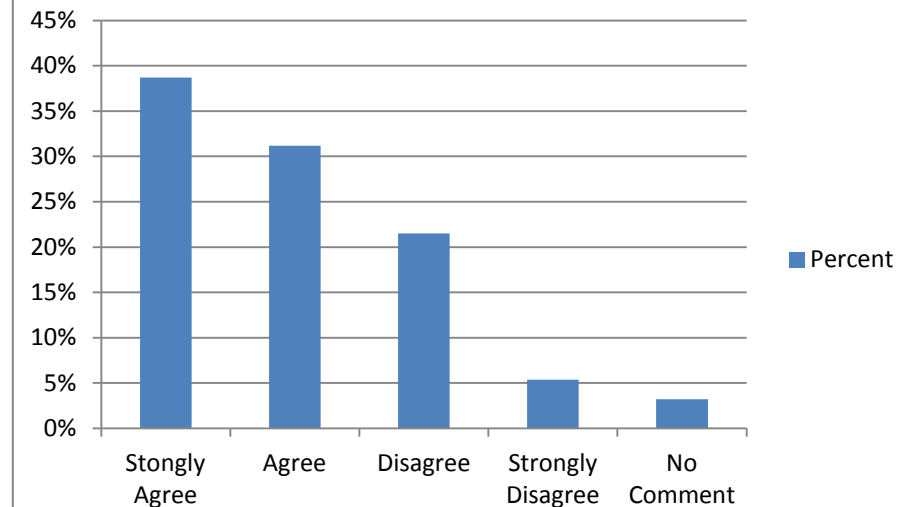

I think teachers could work with parents to help reduce behaviour

Would be good to have lunch time/after school clubs. Language, running, choir.

Parking on the yellow lines needs addressing - a parking warden would help

We have been so happy with Bardsey Primary, our daughter has settled very quickly - a credit to the staff in reception.

I would like the playground surfaces improving; children graze easily on the rough surfaces.

Texts from school are very welcome but arrive with little notice

CP notices in more prominent places

Our daughter joined Bardsey mid-year 4 she is very happy now her teacher supports her learning and helps with extra homework so she can catch up to her peers.

Improvement is needed regards to communication between school and home - short notice texts / notice when child is receiving an award/ requests from parent acted on quicker

Standard of teaching is excellent - although keep on stretching academically

Communication is good although some events are poorly advertised creating confusion

I would support more trips and use of the outdoor area

Golden time activities could have more of a learning focus e.g. learning to dance, Knit, gardening, and riding a bike.

Concerns over traffic and parking - reception gate leads straight onto the road - I often get blocked in as parents park so close to each other (bumper to bumper)
