- Continue to prioritise staff professional development to ensure that all PE lessons are characterised by full engagement, high energy and enjoyment for all pupils. Skills are improved through good subject knowledge and teaching.
- PE lessons are fully resourced in order to achieve the highest attainment levels for all children.
- Develop leadership opportunities for pupils throughout the school.
- To provide specialist coaches to lead high quality CPD for staff
- Community Club Links improved with a network of in school pupil representatives.
- To support and engage the least active children through new or additional clubs
